<b>0403-O-05</b>	<p><b>Internet Drug Outlet Fraudulently Claiming NABP Accreditation</b></p> <p>The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy® (NABP®) would like to alert the boards of pharmacy regarding an Internet drug outlet, WellnessFitnessNutrition LLP (WFN), found at <a href="http://www.wellnessfitnessnutrition.com">www.wellnessfitnessnutrition.com</a>. The WFN website fraudulently claims that it is NABP-certified. WFN also posted the attached letter, which falsely claims that WFN and its affiliate, "Dr Hector R. Rodriguez", are certified to practice pharmacy pursuant to the NABP Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Examination Committee™ certification program. As of the morning of March 4, 2014, that letter has been removed from the WFN site. NABP has no record of a Hector R. Rodriguez ever taking the Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Equivalency Examination® or the North American Pharmacist Licensure Examination®. Additionally, the letter includes an EE#, which NABP did not issue to a Hector R. Rodriguez.</p> <p>NABP has never accredited WFN through its pharmacy accreditation programs or approved the site through the NABP e-Advertiser Approval program. Further, NABP never received an application for such programs from WFN. In fact, WFN would not qualify because it offers to sell, without a prescription, prescription drugs such as antibiotics, anabolic steroids, and growth hormones.</p>
