<u>CE Advisory Committee Update</u> – Angela Meggett-Strudwick requested a motion to approve the 3 forms the committee created and updated for the CPE submissions.

Upon motion duly made at 9:38 a.m. by board member Dr. Joseph Drew, and properly seconded by board member, Bridgett Gagne, the Board unanimously voted to approve the new forms for the CPE submissions created by the CE Advisory Committee.

<u>CPA Additional Pathways</u> – Board requested the Legal Team to start sample language for the four (4) year and two (2) year pathway, as well as the automatic mobility to allow our CPAs to move between the different jurisdictions. The Chair requested a timeline and process outline. The Legal Team informed the Board that it would require a legislative amendment in the accountancy code, which is currently being proposed, which would allow only regulatory changes to establish education requirements going forward.

<u>NASBA CPA Evaluation</u> – Ashley Campbell presented the Board with a new program NASBA has initiated for evaluating candidates to speed up the process. Several jurisdictions have already signed on and NASBA is seeking the DC Boards participation in the program to benefit our candidates. Board delayed a decision on this evaluation method at this time because all Board members were not in agreement at this time. The Chair delayed the decision until next meeting.
