Formula Application

- 27 organizations inquired about Formula Application Funding.
- 24 organizations attended the training and technical assistance workshops.
- 9 organizations submitted logic models (one was rejected due to it being late.)
- 6 organizations are being invited to submit a full application.

Review of Applications

- 12 people have applied to serve as peer reviewers. Only 4 will be selected.
 Commissioners are more than welcome to participate in the staff review of applicants.
 We are asking 2 commissioners to service as facilitators to guide and support the work of the reviewers. Facilitators do not read or rank the applications, however; they do need to be available on June 2 from 9:00 to noon or 1:00pm to 4:00pm. It is the responsibility of the facilitators to:
 - Ensure that panelists observe the schedule.
 - Manage the flow of documentation during the peer review panel consensus session.
 - Resolve any conflicts among the panelists and guide them to consensus on ranking and evaluating the proposals.
 - Ensure that all proposals and notes are collected at the end of the consensus session and that all documents will have signatures as required.
- Serve DC staff will provide
 - A brief training session for the facilitator to familiarize him/her with the overall goals and objectives of the grant competition and the role of the facilitator.
 - A document to capture overall comments and scores, such as an Excel spreadsheet.
