RESOLUTION 2023-1:

Supporting Enhanced Mentoring Efforts and Non-punitive Forms of Engagement

Date of vote: January 10, 2023

Note about JJAG voting requirements: For a recommendation/resolution to pass, a majority of members must be present to vote and thirteen (13) YES votes (51% or greater of JJAGs 24 members) are required.

The resolution was voted on at 5:56 PM – Kyla Woods made the motion to vote, and Jen DiToro seconded the motion. Fifteen JJAG members (or proxies) were present during the roll call vote, and 15 YES votes were recorded (UNANIMOUS). The Resolution passes and will be reported to the Deputy Mayor of Public Safety and Justice.
